The Bremerton Housing Authority's Board of Commissioners decided Monday to name the assisted-living facility under construction in Westpark Bay Vista Commons.

The complex, at the eastern end of the Westpark public housing complex, will have 72 units, including 12 for Alzheimer's patients and 60 for Medicaid recipients. The new facility will join the Firs, a housing complex for seniors and disabled adults.

Development of Bay Vista, formerly known as the Firs II, is one step in a near total redevelopment of

Westpark from 1940s-era housing to a brand new mix of housing options.

Kathryn Jerkovich, Westpark project manager for Marathon Development, the company developing the new Westpark, said Bay Vista is expected to be ready to open in mid-2007.
